Richard Dixon is the Executive Director of the Centre for Applied Business Research in Energy and the Environment's (CABREE). His background includes expertise in energy economics, scenario planning, strategic planning, policy and foresight, particularly as it relates to the energy and environment sectors. Most recently Mr. Dixon led the Strategic Intelligence unit in Alberta Environment where he was responsible for identifying key emerging energy and environmental issues and developing proactive strategic responses for the Ministry and the Government of Alberta.

In the Alberta government he co-chaired the government's Emissions Trading Project which won the Premier's Gold Award of Excellence and was used as a basis for development of the Province's Specified Gas Emitters Regulation and Program.
